

Oquirrh Mountain Dress Code FAQ's

Q- Where can I shop?

A - Anywhere uniform styles are available.

Q - Can my child wear khakis and a polo every day?

A - Yes.

Q - Can my daughter wear a polo dress?

A -Yes.

Q – I didn't see any pleats in the pictures, are they allowed?

A – Yes, the photos on the website are just examples of some appropriate styles. Pleats are acceptable.

Q – What about cargo pants?

A – No, cargo (big pocket pants) are not allowed.

Q – Can my daughter wear leggings?

A – Yes, if they're worn like tights covering entire leg.

Q – Will there still be jean-Friday?

A – No, but every Friday will be spirit day so they can wear the Qquirrh Mountain T-shirt, sweatshirt or college shirts.

Q – Can my student wear grey pants?

A – Yes.

Q – Does my son have to wear a tie?

A – No.

Q – Can my child wear a different plaid if it has the school colors?

A – No. It must be the school plaid.

Q – What will happen if my child is not in compliance with the dress code?

A – They will go to the office and a call will be made to the parent/guardian to bring the appropriate attire so the student can attend class.

Q – What is the shoe standard?

A – Shoe color should be conservative following school colors. This is difficult for most children's, non-dress, shoes. Shoes with different shades of the school colors are OK. The key is that the shoe should not draw attention to itself. Shoes that are of school color but with bright soles such as red or green do not fit that description. Remember that bright colored laces are not approved.
